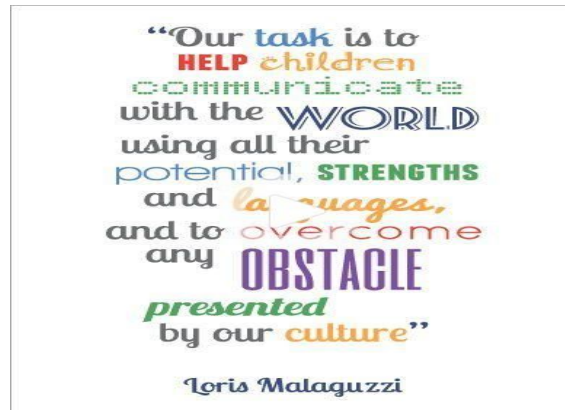

Training Announcements

Training announcements will be mailed out semi-annually. Additional scheduled workshops are mailed individually.

Cost

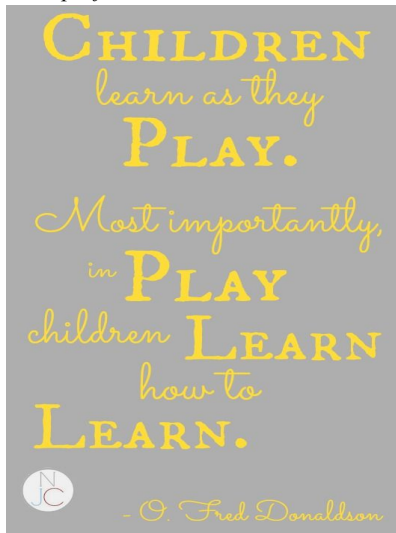
