The new Emergency Preparedness and Response (EPR) in Child Care Training provides early educators with information and tools to prepare for many types of emergencies. The EPR in Child Care Training addresses new NC Child Care Rules on emergency preparedness, current best practices, as well as recommendations, and guidance on completing the online EPR Plan. The EPR Plan template can be found on the North Carolina Emergency Management website. The training is presented in two two-hour sessions and includes a one-hour site assignment. NC Child Care Rules 10A NCAC 09 .0607 (b) and 10A NCAC 09 .01705 (b) (6) require that a designated individual from each licensed center and family child care home complete the training and submit a facility EPR Plan.


